

New York City Newspapers on Strike

From 1923 through 1978, several newspaper strikes caused disruption in the publication of the following titles:

1958: December 11–28 The delivery trucks went on strike Dec. 9, and the printers union Dec. 10. Most papers resumed Dec. 29.	<i>Herald Tribune, Journal American, Long Island Press, Long Island Star Journal, Mirror, NYT, News, Post, World-Telegram-Sun</i>	Not Available
1962–63: Dec. 8–March 31	<i>Herald-Tribune, Journal American, Long Island Star Journal, Long Island Press, NYT, World Telegram</i>	Not Available
1965: Sept. 16–Oct. 10 The Newspaper Guild called a strike at the NYT, and the other papers closed in protest as fellow members of the Publishers Association. The <i>Herald Tribune</i> resigned from PA Sept. 25. All papers resumed Oct. 10, except: <i>Herald Tribune</i> , Sept. 27 and the <i>NYT</i> , Oct. 11.	<i>Herald Tribune, Journal American, Long Island Press, Long Island Star Journal, NYT, News, World Telegram</i>	<i>Daily Mirror, Bridgeport Herald, Long Island Press (Nassau Ed.), Philadelphia Inquirer, Post</i> (had resigned from PA in 1963), <i>Christian Science Monitor, NYT (International Ed., published in Paris; indexed for the Times Index.)*</i>
1978: Aug. 10–Nov. 5 The <i>NYT</i> and <i>Post</i> resumed publication Nov. 6, the <i>Post</i> Oct. 5.	<i>NYT, News, Post</i>	The <i>NYT</i> abstracted and indexed the New York News Wire Services, the Associated Press, and financial wire services. These transcripts can be found on the microfilm reels covering these dates; references to this material are included in the <i>NYT</i> bound index.
