- ❖ **Business & Company Resource Center.** Provides detailed company information, industry overviews and related business information.
- ❖ **Business Source Premiere.** Provides full text access to over 2500 business journals.
- ❖ **Gale Virtual Reference Library.** Provides access to a wide range of reference tools including encyclopedias, almanacs and handbooks.
- ❖ **Regional Business News.** Provides full text access to regional business journals, newspapers and newswires.
