


The gentlemen's pants show till now the disadvantage that the aperture slit in front is not an entire lock.

This advantage avoids the drawn new pantaloons a, as the aperture slit b is diagonal to the long axis of the body, and is covered by a part of

stuff of the same material as the pantaloons a which hangs down inside.

The flap c may extend far off to the step, thereby the pantaloons will be clear for longer time.
