Abstract:	The Stokes Family Genealogical Research Papers consist of genealogical research materials compiled and collected by Anson Phelps Stokes, author of the <i>Stokes Records</i> (1910), and his daughter, Helen Phelps Stokes on the Phelps and Stokes families, who were primarily bankers and merchants in New England and New York in the nineteenth and twentieth centuries. Materials in the collection include correspondence, manuscripts of genealogical works, family trees, genealogical pamphlets, notes, numerous copies and a small number of original family documents. Highlights include correspondence (1843-1847) of Anson Greene Phelps and his daughters, Caroline Phelps Stokes and Elizabeth Phelps James and an 1867 safe conduct for James Stokes signed by William H. Seward.

Biographical note

Anson Greene Phelps (1781-1853) was a New York merchant, a member of the New York Young Men's Bible Society, a descendant of Massachusetts Bay Colony Governor Thomas Dudley and the founder of the Phelps, Dodge & Co. import-export business. He took three sons-in-law into the business, William Earl Dodge (the son of Phelps' business partner, David Low Dodge), Daniel James, and James Stokes (the son of British-born merchant Thomas Stokes, who was also in business with Phelps). Although the sons-in-law became the senior partners in the firm after Phelps' death in 1853, friction between the personalities of William Dodge and James Stokes eventually led Stokes and his sons to withdraw from the business in 1875.

James and Caroline Phelps Stokes had ten children; the eldest was Anson Greene Phelps Stokes (1838-1913), who reinforced the connection to the Phelps family by marrying Helen Louisa Phelps, daughter of banker Isaac Newton Phelps. In addition to his genealogical works, most notably the *Stokes Records* (1910), Anson Phelps Stokes was the author of many published works on other subjects, including a brief travel memoir, *Cruising in the Caribbean with a Camera* (published in 1903 by Dodd, Mead), and works on bi-metallism and money, *Joint-Metallism*, (published in 1895/6, G.P. Putnam's sons) and *Dangers of the Proposed National Paper-Money Trust* (published in 1898, by the Knickerbocker Press.) Anson and Helen Stokes had nine children including a daughter, Helen Phelps Stokes, who continued her father's genealogical research after his death; and most notably Isaac Newton Phelps Stokes (1867-1944), architect, housing reformer, and author of *The Iconography of Manhattan Island, 1498-1909*.

Scope and content note

This collection consists of genealogical research materials on the Phelps and Stokes families, who were primarily New England and New York bankers and merchants, compiled and collected by Anson Phelps Stokes and his daughter, Helen Phelps Stokes, focusing on the distant English ancestors of the families.

Materials in this collection consist of correspondence with professional researchers and Stokes family members, numerical files (profiles on family members, arranged by number, mostly from the sixteen, seventeenth and eighteenth century, with a few later nineteenth century family member profiles, some of which are accompanied by original documents). Background research materials include copies and transcripts of documents such as court records, indenture documents, patent rolls, estate inventories, newspaper articles, bible records and wills, and genealogical writings and family trees. Manuscripts for genealogical works by Anson Phelps Stokes and Helen Phelps Stokes include the *Stokes Records* (1910), by Anson Phelps Stokes as well as other writings on the family by Helen Phelps Stokes, many of which have corresponding family trees. Original documents in the collection date back to 1709 and correspondence of William E. D. Stokes, who inherited the research materials are from as late as 1960, but the bulk of the collection, created by Anson Phelps Stokes and Helen Phelps Stokes and Helen Phelps Stokes and Helen Phelps Stokes and Helen Phelps Stokes are from 1870-1940.

This series consists of materials collected for background research, including copies and transcripts of documents pertaining to the family members, such as court records, indenture documents, patent rolls, estate inventories, newspaper articles, bible records and wills from the twelfth though eighteenth centuries in England and Connecticut. Other background research materials include family trees and charts, pamphlets, and genealogical notes. This series also includes published pamphlets and essays (1903-1941) on the history of the Stokes family and their connections, not written by Anson Phelps Stokes and Helen Phelps Stokes.
