BIOGRAPHY

Evert Augustus Duyckinck (1816-1878), editor and biographer, son of Evert and Harriet June Duyckinck, and the elder brother of George Long Duyckinck (1823-1863). Evert Duyckinck Sr., (1764?-1833), was a publisher of standard literature in New York City.

Duyckinck's higher education: Columbia College B.A. (1835); John Anthon LLD, admitted to the bar (1837).

Duyckinck did not practice law; instead like his father, he opted for a literary career which began by submitting articles to the New York Review. He married Margaret Wolfe Panton in 1840. Their marriage produced three sons Evert, George and Henry all of whom died young. Duyckinck jointly edited with ~~Corneilius Mathews~~ the Arcturus, a Journal of Books and Opinions between 1840-1842. He edited the Literary World for Osgood & Co. (1853). Evert with his brother George bought the Literary World (1853). They jointly edited it between 1848-1853.

Together, the Duyckinck brothers edited the Cyclopaedia of American Literature (2 vols, 1855); Evert later revised it after the death of his brother George (2 vols. & supplement, 1866). Duyckinck edited other works and he compiled Irvingiana, Anecdotes & Traits of Washington Irving.

George Long Duyckinck (1823-1863), editor, biographer and the younger brother of Evert Augustus Duyckinck. Duyckinck's higher education: Hobart College (year?); City University of the City of New York LLD, (1843).

Duyckinck followed the career choice of his brother by entering the literary world and by not practicing law. Besides editing the Literary World, his other accomplishments include a biography of George Herbert (1858).

DUYCKINCK FAMILY PAPERS

DESCRIPTION

The Duyckinck Family Papers, 1793-1899, were given to the Lenox Library in 1890 (Note: the Lenox Library was consolidated into the New York Public Library: Astor, Lenox and Tilden Foundation) by Margaret Wolfe Duyckinck, widow of Evert Augustus Duyckinck (1816-1878).

The Duyckinck Family Papers were part of the Duyckinck Collection comprising, in addition to the family papers, some 15,000 books and 1,500 pamphlets relating to English and American literature collected by George Long Duyckinck (1823-1863), Evert Augustus Duyckinck (1816-1878) and their father Evert Duyckinck (b-d?), printer, publisher, and book dealer in New York City. The books and pamphlets were sent to the Genral Research Division. About 10,000 items from the Duyckinck Collection have been listed in the Lenox Library's Short Title List, Nos. 8, 12 (1887,1890).

The Duyckinck Family Papers were arranged by the Lenox library staff into their present main series, although in common practice of the time period, no box listing or inventory was made.

The bulk of the papers represents Evert Augustus Duyckinck and his brother George Long Duyckinck. the arrangement is mainly by family members: Evert Augustus Duyckinck, George Long Duyckinck, Evert Duyckinck Sr., the sons of Evert Augustus Duyckinck: Evert, George and Henry; Margaret (Wolfe) Duyckinck (Mrs. Evert A. Duyckinck); Pantou family and Roorbach family.

The remaining material consists of miscellaneous papers, subscription letters and miscellaneous records relating to the Literary World; and the Cyclopaedia of American Literature.

The papers are arranged as follows: Literary Correspondence, A-Y, alphabetically arranged, (1793-1899). The literary correspondence consists of incoming letters to Evert A. Duyckinck and George L. Duyckinck in their capacity as editors of Arcturus, the Literary World and the Cyclopaedia of American Literature. The correspondents are from authors including many important American authors of the ante-bellum period, women authors, artists, clergy, poets, historians, associates and colleagues. There are a few draft replies from the Duyckinck brothers.

An alphabetical index is available to the literary correspondents. This index lists the correspondent, year of letters and quantity. Some of the letters have been mounted in the published volume of the Cyclopaedia of American Literature. Cross references to these letters appear in place in the index and the mounted letters have been listed in their serial order.

Another peculiarity of the Literary Correspondence is the occasional appearance of non-literary or historical figures antedating the Duyckincks. These "autographic items" provide further evidence of the artificial nature of the series, collected by the Duyckincks during their literary career.

Evert Augustus Duyckinck papers : General Correspondence, 1830-1878; outgoing letters to his brother George Duyckinck, 1837-1862; Margaret W. Duyckinck (Mrs. Evert A. Duyckinck), 1843-1866; his sons Evert Duyckinck, George Duyckinck and Henry Duyckinck, 1851-1879. Notebooks, commonplace books, diaries, letterbooks, notes, autograph album, accounts, legal papers and miscellaneous papers are included in this series.

George Long Duyckinck papers : Letters received, 1837-1865; N.D.; letters to Evert Augustus Duyckinck, 1838-1861; letters to and from Joann Miller; 1831-1861; N.D.; letters to Mrs. Edward Baker, 1845-1862; Writings which include diaries, 1838-1862, memorandum books and school books. Accounts, 1835-1878 and miscellaneous papers which include calling cards, invitations and catalogues of books.

The Literary World contains: subscription letters, 1849-1854; miscellaneous poems, articles & reviews written for the Literary World; cash books & receipt books, 1847-1854; subscription books and memorandum books, 1846-1851; and miscellaneous papers.

Evert Duyckinck Sr. papers: Letters, 1789-1832; accounts, 1792-1833; Harriet Duyckinck (Mrs. Evert Duyckinck Sr.), accounts 1822-1841; Christopher Duyckinck papers, 1789-1897; Daniel Duyckinck papers, 1801; and receipt books, 1793-1834 and legal papers, 1781-1842.

The papers of Evert Augustus three sons Evert, George and Henry Duyckinck include family correspondence, accounts and writings.

Margaret (Wolfe) Duyckinck papers consists of: letters, 1838-1889;N.D.; commonplace book of poetry, accounts, 1839-1889,n.d.; tax receipts, 1878-1889, etc.; pocket memo books of household expenses, 1873-1889, miscellaneous papers and cancelled checks.

Panton family papers consists of: letters, writings, accounts and legal papers of Catherine C. Panton, Frances Cooper Panton, Francis Panton, Henry Panton, Henry H. Panton, Jane Panton, John Panton, Margaret M. Panton, Mrs. Margaret Mackrell, Catherine Wolf, Christopher Wolfe, and John A. Wolfe.

Sophia Roorbach papers consists of: letters, 1810-1851,n.d.; letters from her brother James Giles, 1779-1825; miscellaneous papers and the last will & testament.

The miscellaneous papers contains bibliographical notes, clippings, etc.

The Cyclopaedia of American Literature (extra-illustrated) contains original autograph letters inserted between the text. A list is available of the autograph letters.
