Abstract

The Meredith Monk Archive documents the art of Meredith Monk and the history of The House Foundation For The Arts, Monk's management and production company. The Archive contains correspondence, media clippings, concert programs, publicity material, writings, piece and project files, scores, business and financial papers, photographs and drawings, posters, and books.

Biographical Note

Meredith Monk (born New York, NY, Nov. 20, 1942) is a composer, singer, director/choreographer and creator of new opera, music theater works, films and installations. She pioneered what is now called "extended vocal technique" and "interdisciplinary performance." During a career that spans more than 40 years she has been acclaimed by audiences and critics as a major creative force in the performing arts.

Since graduating from Sarah Lawrence College in 1964, Monk has received numerous awards, including the MacArthur Foundation "Genius" Award in 1995, two Guggenheim Fellowships, a Brandeis Creative Arts Award, three "Obies" (including an award for Sustained Achievement), two Villager Awards, two "Bessie" awards for Sustained Creative Achievement, the 1986 National Music Theatre Award, the 1992 Dance Magazine Award and a 2005 ASCAP Concert Music Award. She is a fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences and holds honorary Doctor of Arts degrees from Bard College, the University of the Arts, the Julliard School, the San Francisco Art Institute and the Boston Conservatory. She is also a fellow of the MacDowell Colony.

Monk's recordings *Dolmen Music* (ECM New Series) and *Our Lady of Late: The Vanguard Tapes* (Wergo) were honored with the German Critics Prize for Best Records of 1981 and 1986. Her music has been heard in many films, including *La Nouvelle Vague* by Jean-Luc Godard and *The Big Lebowski* by Joel and Ethan Coen. A publishing relationship with Boosey & Hawkes has made Monk's music available to a wider public.

In 1968 Monk founded The House, a company dedicated to an interdisciplinary approach to performance. In 1978 she formed Meredith Monk and Vocal Ensemble to expand her musical textures and forms. Monk has made more than a dozen recordings, most of which are on the ECM New Series label. Her music has been performed by numerous soloists and groups including The Chorus of the San Francisco Symphony, Musica Sacra, The Pacific Mozart Ensemble, Double Edge, and Bang On A Can All-Stars, among others.

Monk is a pioneer in site-specific performance, creating works such as *Juice: A Theater Cantata In 3 Installments* (1969) (performed at the Guggenheim Museum), and *American Archeology #1: Roosevelt Island* (1994). She is also an accomplished filmmaker who has made a series of award-winning films including *Ellis Island* (1981) and her first feature, *Book Of Days* (1988), which was aired on PBS, shown at the New York Film Festival and selected for the Whitney Museum's Biennial. A retrospective art exhibition, *Meredith Monk: Archeology of an Artist*, opened at The New York Public Library for the Performing Arts at Lincoln Center in 1996. Other art exhibits have included *Art Performs Life* at The Walker Art Center in Minneapolis; *Shrines*, at the Frederieke Taylor / TZ Art Gallery; ev +a 2002 Exhibition at Limerick City Gallery of Art in Ireland; and a group exhibit, *Show People*, at Exit Art. A monograph, *Meredith Monk*, edited by Deborah Jowitt was published by Johns Hopkins Press in 1997.

In October 1999 Monk performed a *Vocal Offering* for His Holiness, the Dalai Lama as part of the World Festival of Sacred Music in Los Angeles. In July 2000 her music was honored by a three concert retrospective entitled *Voice Travel* as part of the Lincoln Center Festival. Her CD *mercy* was released on the ECM New Series label in November 2002. Monk's first orchestra piece, *Possible Sky*, commissioned by Michael Tilson Thomas for the New World Symphony, premiered in April 2003 in Miami. *Stringsongs*, her first composition for string quartet, was commissioned by the Kronos Quartet and had its world premiere at the Barbican Center in January 2005. Monk continues to compose and create new musical and theatre works.

Scope and Content Note

The Meredith Monk Archive contains substantial documentation of both the artistic and business aspects of Monk's career and the workings of her company, The House Foundation For The Arts. Major elements of the Archive include personal correspondence; comprehensive collections of concert programs, media clippings, publicity materials and posters; piece and project files, some of which contain Monk's notes and sketches detailing the evolution of certain works; writings by and about Monk; scores; photographs and drawings; financial and other papers documenting the work of The House Foundation since its inception in 1968; and a collection of books about Monk and the art forms in which she works.

The personal correspondence consists mainly of short notes and fan letters to Monk from friends and admirers. Clippings and concert programs can be researched in two different series, one set organized chronologically and the other by associated piece or project. The piece and project files mostly detail the performance history and media reception of Monk's work; earlier files generally contain more of Monk's notes and sketches than later files. Many project files from throughout Monk's career also contain photographs of her work in rehearsal and performance (see Series VIII). Pieces with substantial historical documentation include 16 Millimeter Earrings, American Archeology #1: Roosevelt Island, Art Performs Life, Atlas, Book Of Days, Education Of The Girlchild, Quarry, and the Tour series. In addition to articles and essays by Monk, the writings include many interviews and interview transcripts with her, as well as academic dissertations and other writings about Monk and her work. While the Archive includes some music scores, they do not form a significant portion of the collection because written scores have never been an important part of Monk's working method.

The papers of the House Foundation constitute major portions of the Archive and consist mostly of financial, tax, development and other business records. The touring and activity records of the House document Monk and her company's many tours around the United States and the world and include travel and booking records as well as itineraries and repertory information.

Series Descriptions

Series I: Correspondence, 1959-2006 and undated

5 boxes

Alphabetical

This series consists primarily of personal and fan letters to Monk from friends, collaborators and, in some cases, strangers. Correspondents include Björk, David Byrne, Michael Cerveris, Blythe Danner, Kenneth King and Rob McBrien (the latter two are longtime friends and collaborators of Monk), as well as Monk's family and other close friends. Many of the letters are of congratulations following major events such as significant New York performances or the announcement of Monk's MacArthur Fellowship. There are also nine folders of unidentified correspondents, arranged chronologically.

Series II: Clippings, 1963-2006 and undated

9 boxes

Chronological

This series consists of an extensive set of media clippings documenting every stage of Monk's career, beginning while she was still a student at Sarah Lawrence College. Most of the earlier clippings are from New York area newspapers and magazines, but in later years Monk and her staff collected myriad clippings while on tour around the world, and others were sent at a later date by local presenters. Another set of clippings, overlapping with the content of this series, is arranged by project in Series V, Piece And Project Files. See also Oversized Clippings in Box 293, Folder 1, and anthologized journalism in Box 28, Folders 6-7.

Series III: Programs, Flyers And Press Releases, 1960-2006 and undated 11 boxes

Chronological

Composed mainly of performance programs, this series also contains press releases and other promotional material for Monk's work. Many of the earlier posters and flyers were designed and produced by Monk herself. Programs for many of Monk's pieces can also be found in Series V, Piece And Project Files, arranged by project name. Series VII, Sub-series 2, Development, contains programs for benefits for The House Foundation for the Arts in which Monk performed. See also posters in Oversized Material, Boxes 293-296.

Series IV: Writings, 1969-2006 and undated

3 boxes

This series consists of Monk's writings and public addresses and writings about Monk by critics, academicians, students and other artists. It also contains a set of interview transcripts of Monk, as well as student papers and theses. See also dissertations and other writings about Monk in books in Series X.

Sub-series 1 – By Meredith Monk, 1972-2004

21 folders

Categorical

This sub-series is divided into Articles, Essays and Speeches; Interview Transcripts; Notes and Blurbs; and Recording Liner Notes. Among Monk's essays are her eulogy for John Cage (Box 26, Folder 5), notes on her composition *Our Lady Of Late* (Box 26, Folder 9), a journal about rehearsals for the 1985 revival of *Quarry* (Box 26, Folder 11), Monk's 1985 Commencement address at Sarah Lawrence College (Box 26, Folder 12), and *Mosaic*, an essay about her artistic development and the evolution of her work (Box 26, Folder 8). The unedited interview transcripts (often sent to Monk by journalists after articles they wrote about her were published) are mostly unpublished. See also Sound Recordings in Separated Material for recorded interviews of Monk.

Sub-series 2 – By Others, 1969-2006 and undated

34 folders

Categorical

Most of this sub-series consists of academic writing from scholars, professors and students ranging from secondary to graduate school levels. These include published scholarly articles about Monk, student papers and dissertations, and university student feedback on workshops presented by Monk. Other writings include manuscripts, book proposals and anthologized writings by journalists, including Deborah Jowitt; and program and recording liner notes, including Lanny Harrison's article *Working With Meredith* (Box 28, Folder 8).

Series V: Piece And Project Files, 1966-2006 and undated

31.5 boxes

Alphabetical

This series consists mainly of clippings and programs relating to each of Monk's pieces and other projects. Occasionally there is other documentation, at times extensive, including sketches; notes; correspondence; venue, lighting and other stage information; box office records and other business documentation; and promotional material. Pieces with important documentation beyond programs and clippings include 16 Millimeter Earrings, American Archeology #1: Roosevelt Island, Art Performs Life, Atlas, Book Of Days (much documentation of all its manifesations), Education Of The Girlchild, Quarry, and the Tour series. See also Series VIII: Photographs, which has separate files for many of the pieces found in this series.

Alphabetical

Scores have never been an important or common part of Monk's work process; many of her vocal techniques are difficult to notate, and she rarely has proclaimed any of her musical works finished enough to be codified in the form of a score. This series contains full, "finished" scores for *Our Lady Of Late* and *The Politics Of Quiet*, and a "working score" for *Atlas: an opera in three parts* (for rehearsal use only, not for publication). The latter two scores contain explanatory notes from Monk. Other pieces, such as music for *Quarry* and *MATA Chant*, consist only of melodic sketches. Other works in this series include *Tablet* for women's voices, piano and recorder; *Totentanz* for six voices and keyboard; and informal pieces like *Wedding Song For Andrea And Bert*. See also Box 32, Folder 7 and correspondence in Box 38, Folder 3.

Series VII: House Foundation For The Arts

225 boxes

Most of this series documents the business and financial workings of The House, a non-profit organization that Monk founded in 1968 to run her business and present her work. The first two sub-series, Financial Records and Development, consist mostly of business documents, though Development also has some performance documentation because Monk performed for many of her own benefits. The Activity Files and Touring sub-series mostly document Monk's performance activities, and have some overlapping content; the Activity Files document Monk's vocal workshops and art installations in addition to tours and performances, and includes contracts and presenter correspondence, while the Touring Files contain information on the mechanics of booking, networking, travel and publicity surrounding Monk's tours. The last sub-series, General, contains House papers not directly related to Monk's performance activities or financial records.

Sub-series 1 – Financial Records, 1980-1999

121.5 Boxes

Chronological

Arranged by fiscal year, this sub-series contains accounting, payroll and bank statements, receipts and records of bills paid, annual budget reports and outside audits, tax returns, ledgers and balance sheets, investment information, labor and unemployment records, and other financial records. It contains almost no information pertaining to Meredith Monk's artistic output, with the exception of Box 91, Folder 12, which contains Monk's application to the MacDowell Colony in 1987 to work on her opera *Atlas*.

Sub-series 2 – Development, 1976-1997

27 Boxes

Alphabetical

This sub-series consists of correspondence, invitations to benefits, response cards, promotional material for benefits, benefit programs, board correspondence and meeting minutes, individual contribution records, grant proposals and associated correspondence, and information on corporate, government and non-profit funding sources. It contains a large number of grant applications to and correspondence with the National Endowment for the Arts dating from 1970.

Correspondence between Monk and the NEA reveals her arguments with the agency to recognize the boundary-crossing nature of her work and her struggle to get it funded within the NEA's genre categories; see Box 200, Folder 8 and Box 203, Folder 3.

Sub-series 3 – Activity Files, 1972-2005

44 Boxes

Chronological

This sub-series consists primarily of documentation of Monk and her company's performances in New York and on tour; files are organized alphabetically within years. More recent files (late 1980s forward) also contain files on Monk's other activities, such as vocal and dance workshops, composing commissions, recordings, and art installations. Files in this sub-series include contracts, box office receipts and correspondence with presenters, correspondence with performers working with Monk, travel information, concerts in New York not related to tours, and correspondence with publishers, ECM Records, and other commercial entities doing business with Monk and/or The House Foundation. Some content in sub-series 4, Touring, overlaps with this sub-series. See also photographs in Series VIII and IX for more documentation of Monk in performance.

Sub-series 4 - Touring, 1969-2006 and undated

24.5 Boxes

Alphabetical

The content of this sub-series, while similar to that of sub-series 3, focuses mainly on the business and practical details of the tours Monk and the House have undertaken. This includes information and literature related to arts booking conferences in the United States and abroad attended by House representatives; clippings, programs, contracts and other information on performance bookings (overlapping with content in sub-series 3); general correspondence with presenters; tour itineraries; travel information about cities and performance venues; promotional material from Rena Shagan Associates (booking agent for the House); and repertory lists.

Sub-series 5 - General, 1959-2005 and undated

8.5 Boxes

Alphabetical

This sub-series documents Meredith Monk and the House's activities not directly related to touring, including licensing agreements for Monk's music; contracts for publishing and recording; honorary degrees and awards for Monk (including one dating from her high school days); public addresses; documentation of loans made to the House; legal paperwork documenting a lawsuit filed against the House Foundation; and other miscellaneous items.

Series VIII: Photographs And Drawings, 1965-2004 and undated

5 boxes

This series mostly documents Monk's work in performance through photographic prints, contact sheets and negatives, covering most of her major pieces from *16 Millimeter Earrings* (1966) to *Impermanence* (2004), as well as various incarnations of Meredith Monk and Vocal Ensemble and Monk's art installations. There are also some informal photographs of performances and personal photographs of Monk, as well as drawings and sketches by Monk and others. Series IX, Oversized Material, also contains photographs.

Sub-series 1 – Contact Sheets And Negatives, 1965-2000s and undated

1.5 Boxes

Categorical

This sub-series contains images of Monk's pieces in performance on contact sheets, in some cases with negatives. Other items of interest include a contact sheet of location searches for the film *Book Of Days*, images from an exhibit at The New York Public Library for the Performing Arts, a folder of portraits of Monk, and a folder of images of Monk teaching at a school in Brooklyn in 1966.

Sub-series 2 – Prints And Drawings, 1965-2004 and undated

3.5 Boxes

Categorical

This sub-series contains images of most of Monk's work, but certain pieces have substantially more prints than others. These include *Atlas*, *Education Of The Girlchild*, *Facing North*, *The Politics Of Quiet*, and *Volcano Songs*. Some images are from tours and are snapshots taken by House employees, while others are professional photos taken for publicity purposes. Among these are photos of Monk with duet collaborators, including Bobby McFerrin and Nurit Tilles. The folder of drawings includes sketches by Monk and images of Monk drawn by unidentified others.

Series IX: Oversized Material, ca. 1965-2005

5 boxes

This series contains photographs, clippings, programs and posters. The photographs are, like those in Series VIII, mostly of particular pieces in performance or for publicity. The posters mostly promote Monk performances.

Sub-series 1 – Photographs, 1969-1988

1 Box

Categorical

Some of these photographs, such as the images of *Juice* and *Tour 4: Organ*, are mounted. The images of *Quarry* are stills from a film of the piece Monk produced. The folder of Monk portraits contains photographs by Jack Mitchell that are mounted.

Sub-series 2 – Clippings, Programs and Posters, ca. 1965-2005 and undated

4 Boxes

By Format

The clippings in this sub-series are from Israel, 1982. The posters come in two divisions, flat and rolled. Items of interest include several posters from the early 1970s designed by Monk. One of the earliest posters advertises a performance of *16 Millimeter Earrings* at an anti-Vietnam war protest event. Almost all the posters promote performances. One that does not is the floor plan for the Monk exhibit *Art Performs Life* at the Walker Art Center in Minneapolis (Box 293, Folder 5).

Series X: Books, 1965-2004

Alphabetical

All the books in this series are signed by their authors and/or are inscribed with a message to Meredith Monk. Among the books are two doctoral dissertations and an Italian scholarly journal containing an article about Monk.
