Abstract: The Arkraft Strauss Sign Corporation was one of New York City's preeminent sign designers and manufacturers, responsible for creating some of the most iconic signs in American advertising. Particularly known for their "spectaculars"—giant illuminated signs often incorporating special effects and moving parts—Artkraft Strauss' most famous works include the "smoking" Camel Cigarettes sign, the "flying" Anheuser-Busch eagle, and the Coca-Cola sign at 2 Times Square. The company was also responsible for the New Year's Eve ball drop in Times Square, a tradition they began in 1907, until 1996. The records of Artkraft Strauss document over seventy years of operations of this family-owned and family-operated business. The records date primarily from the mid-1930s through 2004; little material pertaining to its early decades is present. The collection contains executive office files; management correspondence; electrical division records; ledgers; press and promotional material; photographs; and, most notably, job files, which illustrate the creation of many of Artkraft Strauss' projects in New York City, Atlantic City, Boston, and elsewhere, from 1936 to 2004. Work represented includes numerous projects for the Anheuser-Busch Company, such as breweries, stadium signage, and multiple Budweiser spectaculars: a British Air spectacular in Times Square involving a scale model of a Concorde iet: theater marquees; and movie signage. The collection also contains a large quantity of audiovisual material, which is closed pending preservation transfer.

**Custodial history:** The Artkraft Strauss Company did not begin maintaining their records until 1932, the year they moved into their West Side factory, thus no files from their early years of operation are present. In addition, the company chose not to retain records for all of their jobs, but rather to highlight select jobs which they felt represented the technical and artistic scope of their work. The company closed its factory in 2006 and held an auction of its holdings, including signs, memorabilia, and blueprints. As a result, the records are not a comprehensive chronicle of the work of Artkraft Strauss.

**Processing note:** The records of the Artkraft Strauss Company have been largely retained in their original order. A notable exception is Series III. Job Files. Artkraft Strauss originally organized their job files by an internally-issued job number, however, these numbers were frequently recycled, leading to duplicate numbers connected with different projects. The job files are now arranged alphabetically by client name.

Researchers should note that material relating to specific jobs may be present in multiple locations. This is especially true of jobs dating from the 1990s; researchers pursuing information on projects from this period should be prepared to consult Series I.A. Project Files, Series III. A. Job Files, and Series III. B. Project Management Files. Likewise, while some job files may contain photographs or images, researchers looking for visual documentation of specific signs should also refer to Series VII. Photographs.

### **Creator history**

The Arkraft Strauss Sign Corporation created some of the most iconic signs in American advertising. A major presence in Times Square since its earliest days, Artkraft Strauss was responsible for the "smoking" Camel Cigarettes sign, the "flying" Anheuser-Busch eagle, the 2 Times Square Coca-Cola sign, and numerous other large-scale illuminated signs referred to in the trade as "spectaculars." The company was also responsible for the New Year's Eve ball drop in Times Square, a tradition they began in 1907, until 1996.

The Artkraft Strauss Sign Corporation had its roots in Strauss Signs, a small sign-painting operation founded in 1897 by Benjamin Strauss. Strauss Signs had a reputation for producing meticulously painted showcards and applying gold leaf lettering to office doors and storefronts, but by the 1920s, the company had grown to become the principle builder of theatre marquees on Broadway, whose work included the original marquees of the New Amsterdam Theatre on 42nd Street, the Ziegfeld Follies, and many of the original Loew's Theatre buildings.

One of Strauss' employees, a Russian immigrant named Jacob Starr, quickly rose to the position of company foreman. He was dubbed "the lamplighter of Broadway" for the enormous quantities of incandescent bulbs used in his signs. In the 1920s, Starr struck out on his own. In 1929, he purchased the Artkraft Company of Lima, Ohio, which held the exclusive North American franchise for neon, a burgeoning technology at that time. Starr returned to New York in 1932 and merged his new company with Benjamin Strauss' Strauss Signs to become Artkraft Strauss.

During World War II, Artkraft supplied custom metal work to the United States military, including hand-made airplane wings and containers for installation in aircraft and tanks. When blackouts and energy shortages limited their ability to illuminate their signs through electricity and neon, the company developed alternative methods, including the use of rechargeable battery packs and dangling mirrors that picked up ambient light.

In the postwar decades, Artkraft grew to employ more than 200 people, many of whom were second-

and third-generation artisans. During this period, they dominated the outdoor advertising market, and created many of the instantly recognizable signs which would become synonymous with Times Square: the Kleenex sign featuring Little Lulu; the animated Canadian Club whisky sign; the Bond Clothing waterfall; and a Budweiser sign atop the Brill Building with an animated neon eagle and "galloping" neon Clydesdales. In addition to the spectaculars of Times Square, Artkraft Strauss was responsible for a number of stadium scoreboards, including those in Busch Memorial Stadium in St. Louis; Philadelphia's Veterans Stadium; Anaheim Center in California; and Shea Stadium in New York.

Artkraft Strauss has historically been a family affair: Starr's son, Mel, became the company's primary designer and salesman in 1939, and later, its president; Mel's daughter, Tama, and son, Jonathan, took the company into the third generation of family ownership and operation after Mel's death in 1988. Tama Starr acquired sole ownership of the company in 1994, and as of 2011 continues to serve as its president and CEO.

Tama Starr's ascendancy coincided with the company's extension into marketing and promotion, advertising space leasing, sign design, and media consulting. It also marked an era in which Artkraft Strauss would become known for more than just their signs; they played an active role in the redevelopment of Times Square through their participation in the 42nd Street Development Project, a joint initiative of the City of New York and the New York State Urban Development Council. The company was awarded an exclusive contract to market ten new advertising displays in the heart of the revitalization area.

Their 1993 creation of an anti-gun sign, the Dehere Gun Fighters of America's Gun Clock—colloquially known as the "Death Clock," a play on the Durst Foundation's Debt Clock, another Artkraft Strauss creation—raised hackles among area businesses and the Times Square BID, who felt that broadcasting crime statistics in Times Square flew in the face of their efforts to rid the neighborhood of crime and to rehabilitate its reputation. This controversy had lingering and deleterious effects for Artkraft Strauss; most notably, it led to a falling out with the Times Square BID, who had promoted the New Year's Eve ball drops since the early 1990s. In 1996, Times Square BID announced that Artkraft Strauss would no longer provide or operate the New Year's Eve ball.

Artkraft Strauss continued to produce some of the most recognizable and innovative displays in New York City in the 1990s. During this period, neon had been eclipsed by other technologies, such as LED, video, and complex computer-operated robotics. Artkraft remained on the cutting edge of these technologies, as evidenced by their work on a number of large, technically sophisticated projects, including a 12 ton, half-scale model of a Concord jet for British Airways; a 48 foot mechanically animated lava lamp for Target; block-long Dow Jones and NASDAQ stock tickers on the face of the Morgan Stanley building; a new Coke sign at 2 Times Square featuring a 40 foot high, 3-dimensional Coke bottle with animated fiber optics and a popping cap; and the Holiday Inn Crowne Plaza marquee, which included an installation of over 15,000 square feet of signage. The company also managed a number of historically significant projects, such as the restoration of Radio City Music Hall's original art decomarquees, the contribution of a bronze marquee, vitrines, and a chandelier to Carnegie Hall, and the refurbishment of the Long Island City Pepsi-Cola sign which the company had originally manufactured and erected in 1936.

Over the years, Artkraft Strauss acquired the assets of smaller companies, and created a number of subsidiaries. Companies that have operated under the umbrella of Artkraft Strauss include Artkraft Strauss Leasing, Inc; Artkraft Infocenter Network; 212 West 43rd Street Corp.; A&S Electrical Displays; Electric Display, Inc; West Side Neon; Globe Maintenance; ESP Signs LTD; Calvano Erectors; El Advertising; and Crossroads Outdoor Advertising. By the end of the 1990s, it had diversified its operations to include marketing and promotion; advertising space leasing; sign design and engineering;

and sign fabrication and installation.

Artkraft Strauss Sign Company closed its factory in 2006, and currently operates as a sign design and consulting company.

### Scope and content note

Artkraft Strauss designed, fabricated, installed, and maintained an extensive range of sign products, including exterior identification signs, theater marquees, billboards, directional signage, and the giant illuminated signs known in the trade as "spectaculars," for which the company was particularly famous. The records of the Artkraft Strauss Sign Corporation document over 70 years of work in the field of outdoor advertising. The collection is arranged in seven series: Executive Office Files; II. Management Correspondence Files; III. Job files; IV. Electrical Division Records; V. Ledgers; VI. Press and Promotional Material; and VII. photographs. The collection also contains audiovisual material, which is closed pending preservation transfer.

The records date primarily from the mid-1930s through 2004. Virtually no material dating prior to the 1930s is extant, as the company did not begin to maintain its corporate records until 1932, the year it moved into its factory on the West side of Manhattan. The company chose not to retain records for all of their jobs, but rather to highlight select jobs which they felt represented the technical and artistic scope of their work. After closing its factory in 2006 the company held an auction of its holdings, including signs, memorabilia, and blueprints. As a result of these factors, the records are not a comprehensive chronicle of the work of Artkraft Strauss, and some of its most recognizable works are underrepresented—or not represented at all—in the collection.

Executive Office Files represent jobs and special projects managed by Tama Starr in her capacity as president of Artkraft Strauss. Management Correspondence Files consist largely of correspondence between Artkraft Strauss' executive, management, and sales teams and their clients. A small quantity of material from the electrical division illustrates the work of the company's electricians in the 1940s through 1970s, as well as providing some of the earliest administrative material in the collection. Ledgers of accounts receivable date from 1946 to 1968, but are not inclusive. Promotional material demonstrates Artkraft Strauss' popularity in the trade and popular presses, while a collection of souvenir postcards of Times Square demonstrates the impact of these outsized displays on the popular imagination.

The iconic signs of Artkraft Strauss are documented in various ways throughout the records, but of particular importance are the Job files, which represent the bulk of the collection and illustrate the creation of many of Artkraft Strauss' famous projects in New York City, Atlantic City, Boston, and other locations from 1936 through 2004. Job files are records of sign construction, which may include sign fabrication, installation, maintenance, alteration, and repairs. Job files may also include cost sheets, labor records, materials specifications, engineering and other technical information, contracts, permits, insurance policies, drawings, layouts, mechanicals, blueprints, photographs, and other material. The projects documented range in scope from street and directional signage to illuminated spectaculars to three-dimensional installations featuring computer-operated robotics. Location presentations and client proposals are also included here, as are contracts, leases, and construction records. Project management files provide an extensive record of large-scale, technologically complex projects undertaken in the 1990s, such as the Morgan Stanley world clock, the renovation of the Dow Jones stock zipper, and state-of-the-art Budweiser and Coke signs at 1 and 2 Times Square.

The photographs series is extensive, and contains not only images of the company's signs, but often of their fabrication and installation. Artkraft Strauss' employees and facilities are also featured. Photographs show sign locations and proposed locations throughout New York City and beyond. Audiovisual material places the company and its work in historical and cultural context through interviews, documentary footage, and b-roll. Series I: Executive Office Files, 1927-2004 (bulk 1984-2004) (41 boxes)

These files were created and maintained by Tama Starr in her capacity as president of Artkraft Strauss, and represent jobs and special projects managed directly by Starr, including the 42nd Street Development Project, the New Year's Eve ball drop in Times Square, and a celebration of the 100th anniversary of Artkraft Strauss in conjunction with an exhibit on the history of Times Square's iconic signage at the New-York Historical Society. Subseries: I.A. Project Files; I.B. 42nd Street Development Project; I.C. Times Square; I.D. New Year's Eve; I. E. Signs and Wonders.

Project files consist predominantly of correspondence with clients, vendors, and city agencies relating to jobs and special projects. Included are internal memoranda and meeting notes; bid applications; project proposals; cost studies and related research; as well as drafts of contracts, license agreements, leases, and other legal instruments. These files also document activity at locations in New York City, particularly in the Times Square vicinity, where Artkraft Strauss erected or maintained signage and spectaculars.

Times Square files contain material regarding the history and development of Times Square, as well as practical information concerning business operations in the area. Included here are files relating to Artkraft Strauss' participation in the 42nd Street Development Project, a redevelopment initiative establishing a 13-acre renewal site along 42nd Street between Broadway and Eighth Avenue.

Artkraft Strauss is closely identified not only with Times Square, but with the New Year's Eve ball drop at One Times Square, which Benjamin Strauss and Jacob Starr originated in 1907. New Year's Eve files contain photographs, press releases, publicity files, and other documentation of annual celebrations in Times Square between 1982 and 1999. No material relating to earlier events is present in this series, though some photographs of ball drops in the 1950s are present in Series VII, Photographs.

Signs and Wonders files relate to an exhibit hosted by the New-York Historical Society, "Signs and Wonders: The Spectacular Lights of Times Square." The exhibit, which featured many of Artkraft's famous signs, coincided with the 100th anniversary of Artkraft Strauss. A companion book written by Tama Starr and Edward Hayman was published by Anchor Press in 1998.

#### I.A. Project Files, 1969-2004

These files document many of Artkraft Strauss' major projects in the 1980s and 1990s from the initial proposal to completion. Files consist predominantly of correspondence with clients and vendors. Also included are internal memoranda and meeting notes; bid applications; project proposals; cost studies and related research; drafts of contracts, license agreements, leases, and other legal instruments. Project files contain information on locations in New York City and elsewhere where Artkraft Strauss leased advertising space. Additional correspondence can be found in Series II. Signcorp management files. Occasionally, photographs, blueprints, and technical specs are extant, though researchers looking for visual documentation of signs and projects should refer to Series III: Job files and Series VII: Photographs for more thorough documentation. Project files are arranged alphabetically; no standard naming convention was implemented by the company, so material may be listed under location, project name, or subject.

### I.B. 42nd Street Development Project, 1972-1999

The 42nd Street Development Project was a collaborative undertaking of the City of New York and the New York State Urban Development Corporation (UDC). The project aimed to alleviate urban blight in the Times Square area by eliminating crime, rehabilitating buildings, and providing support and incentives for neighborhood businesses. Arkraft Strauss was awarded contracts to design, build, market, and manage outdoor advertising for four key sites covered by the plan.

General Files document Artkraft Strauss activities as a partner in the 42nd Street Development Project through internal administrative records including project proposals; memoranda; correspondence with the UDC, City agencies, lawyers, and vendors; design guidelines; and environmental impact statements. Also included are files relating to condemnations initiated by the New York State Urban Development Corporation ("UDC") through eminent domain procedure to acquire parcels of property for redevelopment. Artkraft Strauss had many signs installed on these properties, and frequently wrangled with the UDC over use and occupancy fees, relocation assistance, fixture awards, and other compensation. Site Files document the development of Artkraft's installations at 42nd Street Development Project locations between 1988-1999 through contracts, work orders, correspondence, and other related material.

Files are arranged alphabetically. Some locations are identified only by site numbers assigned internally by Artkraft Strauss; Addresses for these locations or identification of signs installed at these sites have been provided when this information was available. No standard naming convention was implemented by the company, so material may be listed under location, project name, or subject.

### I.D. New Year's Eve, 1982-1996

New Year's Eve files contain correspondence, press releases, publicity files, and other documentation of annual celebrations in Times Square between 1982 and 1999 (not inclusive), as well as material focusing on Artkraft Strauss' participation in the ball drop. Of particular note is "Tama's Red File," which contains correspondence between Tama Starr and various agencies, including the Times Square BID, Times Square District Management Association, Steven Israel of One Times Square Associates, and others, in regards to legal issues and complaints, the bankruptcy of One Times Square (historically, the host location for the ball drop), physical custody of the New Year's Eve ball, efforts by One Times Square Associates to trademark the New Year's Eve celebration, and the contentious relationships between many of the key companies and organizations involved in the ball drop. Also notable are files from 1996, when the Times Square BID replaced Artkraft Strauss with another operator, and replaced the mechanically lowered ball with a computer operated ball, for the first time in the history of the event.

## Series II: Signcorp Management Files, 1940-2002 (25 boxes)

Management files consist largely of correspondence with clients generated by members of the executive, management, and sales teams of Artkraft Strauss Sign Corporation (referred to internally as Signcorp). Clients include advertising agencies, contractors, and corporate entities working directly with Artkraft Strauss, such as Coca-Cola, Anheuser-Busch, and Hiram Walker. Subject matter is administrative and account-related, including sales, letters of agreement, change and maintenance requests. Correspondence with executive officers of West Side Neon, whose assets were acquired by Artkraft Strauss in 1988, is also present.

General correspondence files, which contain both chronological files and files alphabetized by client, are preceded by files identified by staff member. The content is consistent throughout the staff, client, and chronological files; researchers may need to review multiple files. Management staff represented here includes company president Mel Starr; Vice-presidents Herman Hirsch, Gene Kornberg, Michael Leterra, Philip "P.J." Marshall, Neuberger, Robert Jon Starr, and Tama Starr (see also Series I.); controller Victor Balitzer; project managers James Manfredi (see Series III. B.) and Roger Mazzuchelli; salesmen Herbert Blank, Bill Levy, Chaim Ratki, and Lou Grasso; service manager Mike Peras; and executive secretary Helen Nielson.

The material dates almost exclusively from the 1980s onward.

**Series III: Job Files, 1936-2004** (173 boxes, 9 oversize folders, 72 tubes)

Artkraft Strauss designed, fabricated, installed, and maintained an extensive range of sign products, including exterior identification signs, theater marquees, billboards, directional signage, and the giant illuminated signs known in the trade as "spectaculars," for which the company was particularly famous. These signs are documented in various ways throughout the collection, but of particular importance are the Job Files.

Job files are records of sign construction, which may include sign fabrication, installation, maintenance, alteration, and repairs. Many job files contain work orders (sometimes referred to as "Commercial Orders") which give the name of the customer, the date and location of the job, a job number, and a general description of the work. Job files may also hold cost sheets, labor records, materials specifications, engineering and other technical information, contracts, permits, insurance policies, drawings, layouts, mechanicals, blueprints, photographs, and other material. Note that not all job files contain all these elements; the degree of documentation varies widely from job to job.

Files are arranged alphabetically and are not comprehensive. Artkraft Strauss completed as many as 1000 jobs per year; as a result, the company opted to retain only those files they deemed interesting or notable in some way, whether because they contained interesting visual material, had historic or aesthetic significance, or contained other records of particular value. The longstanding relationship between Anheuser Busch and Artkraft Strauss is strongly represented in this series. Extensive documentation is present for work on Anheuser Busch breweries in Boston, Columbus, Houston, Jacksonville, Newark, and St. Louis; as well as material relating to the scoreboard display at Busch Memorial Stadium in St. Louis, and to numerous Budweiser signs and spectaculars in New York City, Atlantic City, and elsewhere in the United States. The company was also responsible for a number of signs for Coca-Cola in Times Square and elsewhere. A number of designs for theatre marquees are present, including many Loews and Broadway theaters.

Artkraft Strauss' largest and most technologically sophisticated projects from the 1980s onward, such as the British Airways installation in Times Square, the Morgan Stanley world clock, and the refurbishment of the Long Island City Pepsi sign, are documented in the project management files maintained by the company's Vice President of Design and Engineering Robert Jackowitz and Vice President of Special Projects James Manfredi. Additionally, some files documenting work for specific clients in the 1980s and 1990s can be found in Tama Starr's executive files, Series I.A.

A small quantity of proposals and presentations are also contained within this series. These records document proposed signs and spectaculars, or provide statistics and feasibility studies relating to particular sign locations. Files are divided into two categories: those relating to specific commercial clients, and those relating to sign locations. Also included are card files containing alphabetized records of construction and maintenance for many Artkraft jobs.

### III. A. Jobs, 1936-2004

Job files are arranged alphabetically by client name, product name, or building address. In some cases, naming conventions are inconsistent; for instance, work done at Shea Stadium is entered under both "New York Mets" and "Shea Stadium." In the event that the job is entered under the name of a parent company or advertising agency, the name of the product or subsidiary is provided in a note as a secondary identifier. Additionally, some files documenting the work of AKS for specific clients in the 1980s and 1990s can be found in Tama Starr's executive files, Series I. The files are not comprehensive. Artkraft Strauss completed as many as 1000 jobs per year; as a result, the company opted to retain only those files they deemed interesting or notable in some way, whether because they contained interesting visual material, had historic or esthetic significance, or contained other records of particular value. The 1960s, 1970s, and 1990s are most robustly documented.

#### III. B. Project Management Files, 1982-2005

Project management files were created and maintained by Robert Jackowitz, Vice President of Design and Engineering, and by James Manfredi, Vice President of Special Projects. These files document projects from the 1980s onward which are notable for their scale and technological sophistication, such as the British Airways spectacular featuring a 12-ton half-scale model of a Concord jet, and the Budweiser sign at One Times Square featuring an LED video screen and tipping Budweiser bottle. Due to their complex and extensive designs, these projects are generally more thoroughly documented than those found in the Jobs files, and usually include administrative files, technical specifications, budgets, timelines, drawings, proof of concept documents, and material relating to the work of companies hired to design or fabricate robotics, digital media, and other precision technical equipment. Leases are between Artkraft Strauss and the owner of the property or sign location which Artkraft Strauss rented on behalf of their clients to display their signs. Many files contain insurance policies. One file relates to construction and sign rigging. Leasing companies include Atlantic Leasing Company and Crossroads Outdoor Advertising; Crossroads was a subsidiary of Artkraft Strauss which operated in the 1970s and 1980s for the purpose of holding sign leases. Construction card files document construction, maintenance, and repair work done on signs erected in the 1970s through 1990s, and are arranged alphabetically by client.
