Biography/History

Courtlandt Palmer was born in 1871, to a wealthy New York family. Palmer studied music in Italy with Giovanni Sgambati, a student of Franz Liszt. Although Palmer was not well known, he was highly regarded by critics as well as by professional colleagues. His music was played in concert halls around New York City in the early twentieth century. Palmer was also on the executive committee of the Friends of Music society, which supported new American composers.

Scope and Content Note

The Courtlandt Palmer Scores contains manuscripts and published editions of Palmer music. The unidentified scores contain transcriptions and studies of other composers by Palmer. The oversized scores are photostat copies of works by Palmer.
