



## Electronic Resources for our Young Researchers

The New York Public Library has loads of resources available just for kids. From story-telling to searching, nothing is left to the imagination when using our resources.

- ❖ **BookFlix**- plays the narration while highlighting the words of the story across the screen (PreK-3)
- ❖ **Kids Search**- an easy to use database for students to search by keyword or by topic to find the most useful information (K-8)
- ❖ **Learning Express Library**- provides practice tests in Math and Reading, starting with grades 4- College
- ❖ **Searchasaurus**- includes a dictionary and encyclopedia geared for young researchers, full-text articles from over 80 magazines and pamphlets appropriate for children in grades 1-3
- ❖ **TumbleBooks**- includes animated-talking picture books, story books, and books in other languages, puzzles and games. Each story provides the appropriate grade level
