- Water

### **TRY IT OUT!**

- 1. Blow up a balloon and hold it for 30 seconds to stretch.

- 3. Fill the balloon (or ice cube tray) with water and tie it closed.
- 4. Put the balloon (or ice cube tray) in the freezer.
- 5. Place your frozen egg in a bowl or dish and add warm water to melt.
